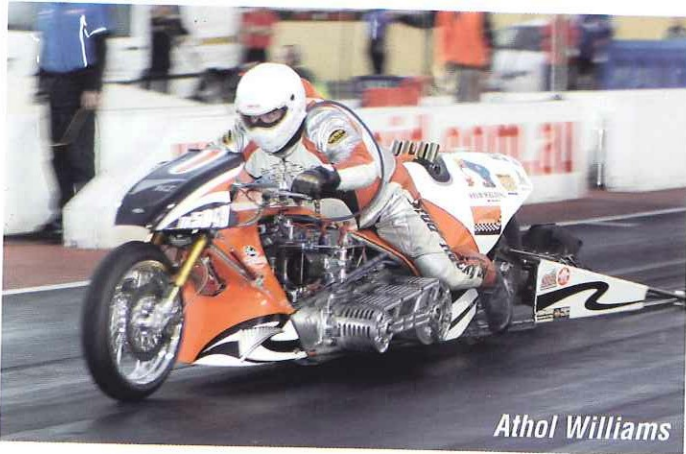


8-1 - ROB TUCKER

8-1 - PHIL & SAM PARKER

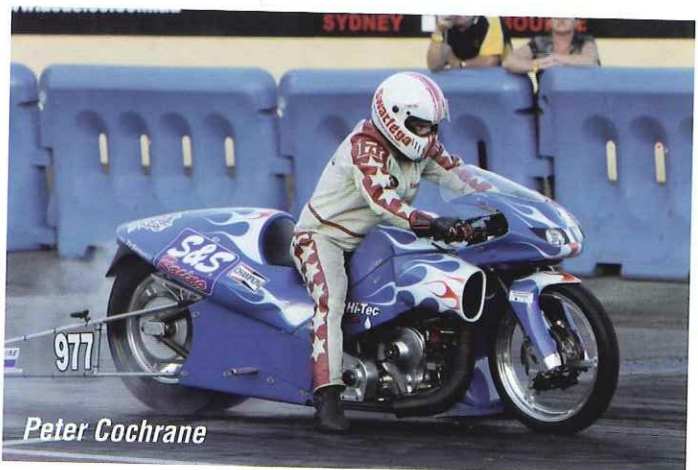
Both the Parker's Dad Phil and son Sam have an equal shot at this deal, Sam having some drama with his new mount but a little luck and all the drama is out the door.
